Hawthorne Toba	1 1/4"	12-15'	Developed in Canada. Fragrant white double flowers turn to pink. Shiny leaves
Lilac James McFarlane	4-6'	8'	True pink blooms 2 weeks after most. Very hardy, adapts to moist conditions.
Linden Greenspire	2"	40'	Straight growing dark green tree. Sweet vanilla fragrance. Lite white flowers spring.
Locust Shademaster	2"	40-50'	Straight growing thornless. Drought tolerant. Good Boulevard tree. Hardy & seedless

Autumn Blaze	1 3/4"	50'	Fairly rapid growth, orange red fall color, hardy and grows in most soils.

Deborah	1 3/4"	40-60'	Broadly oval. Brilliant red foliage turning dark green in summer.
Fairview	2 1/2"	40'	Straight fast grower, new leaves are dark red turning red as they mature. Green fall.
Ginnala Clump	6-8'	15-20'	Beautiful red/orange fall. Fast growing hardy.
Helena	1 1/2"	50'	Fine green leaves, very hardy. Developed in Helena Montana.
Pattern Perfect	1 3/4"	20'	Round habit with thick green leaves. Orange red fall color, very hardy.
Sensation Boxelder	2"	40'	attractive pinkish leaf in summer, fast grower, soft pinish- red in fall
Mayday Redleaf (merlot)	1 3/4"	18'	Narrower growing than Canada Red Cherry & non suckering. Helena bred.
Mountain Ash Oakleaf	2 1/4"	30'	fireblight resistant, orange-red fruit, lobed dark green foliage
Pear Prairie Gem	1 1/2" 1 3/4"	15-20'	Very dense white flowering tree. Hardy and can bear some pears.

Canada Red Cherry	1 3/4"	25'	White flowers, new green leaves turn to wine/red in June, very hardy,

Golden	2 1/2"	30'	Yellow stems, very hardy large shrub or small tree.

Austrian		50'	Darkest green of all pines, heavy, long needle with strong northwoods scent.
Bristle Cone	4-5' 5-6'	20'	Slow growing, dark green hardy pine. Irregular shape. Great accent plant.
Dwarf Mugo	3 gal.	3-5'	dwarf, bright green color in all seasons, very hardy and rugged, full sun

Colorado	15 gal. 20 gal 3' 5' 6' 8'	60'	varies in color from gray-green to blue-green. broad, pyramid-shaped extremely hardy, deer resistant. Very good drought tolerance.
Fastigiata Columnar Blue spruce	7 gal	15-20'x4-5'	Narrow growing blue spruce with nice steel blue color
Spruce Fat Albert	15 gal.	15' x 8'	Very dense, slow growing, exceptional color, great for small area.
Spruce Globe	15 gal.	3-5'	Slow growing compact rounded form with exceptional blue color. Very hardy.
Spruce Globe High Grafted	10 gal	3-8' x 5-6' W.	Slow growing rounded form with exceptional blue color. Great accent plant
Rocky Mtn. Juniper	2'	12-15'	Native upright juniper to area. Blue berries that birds love. Hardy drought tolerant.
